- Eye, hearing, clothing and foot protection MUST be worn.**
- A dust mask MUST be worn** when operating this equipment.
- Gloves MUST NOT be worn** when operating this equipment.
- Hair MUST be covered or restrained.**
- Know where emergency **STOP** button is located.
- Ensure power is **OFF** before proceeding with safety checks.
- Check leads and switches for damage before use.
- Clear table of any debris.
- Be aware of other personnel in the immediate vicinity.
- Use correct tools to change router bits, check router bits for any damage.
- Set up spindle fence and secure firmly to carriage table.
- Set guard to correct height.
- After all checks have been made turn main power **on** and test run.
- Keep hands clear of moving components and machinery.
- Operate bench router with extreme caution.
- Do not overload the motor.
- Never leave running machine unattended.
- Turn **OFF** power supply and isolate immediately when finished.
- Clean bench router and work area when finished.
