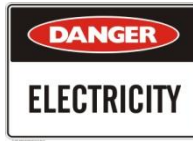


CIRCULAR SAW

1. **Eye, hearing, clothing and foot protection MUST be worn.**
2. **A dust mask MUST be worn** when operating this equipment.
3. **Hair MUST be covered or restrained.**
4. Know where emergency **STOP** button is located.
5. Ensure machine is **OFF** before proceeding with safety checks.
6. Isolate electric motor and inspect blade for correct set and sharpness.
7. Position fence at correct size.
8. Set hood guard to correct height.
9. **KEEP HANDS CLEAR OF THE BLADE.**
10. Start machine and allow blade to reach maximum revolution before cutting.
11. Hold timber firmly with both hands and push timber into saw at a steady pace, allowing the saw to cut correctly.
12. For small pieces of timber use a push stick if necessary.
13. Get assistance for long work.
14. Use correct manual handling techniques and maintain a balanced stance.
15. Turn **OFF** and isolate power supply immediately when finished.
