

1. **Eye, hearing, clothing and foot protection MUST be worn.**
2. **Hair MUST be covered or restrained.**
3. Know where the emergency **STOP** button is located.
4. Make sure power is **OFF** before proceeding with safety checks.
5. Ensure the area is clear before starting equipment.
6. Check electric cord and plug are in good condition.
7. Clear all off cuts and ensure table is clean.
8. Place material to be cut into vice or clamps.
9. Use stands on both sides to support and hold long lengths of material.
10. Check blade for damage and ensure all guards are in position.
11. After all checks have been made turn main power **on**.
12. Keep clear of moving components and machinery.
13. Turn **OFF** and isolate power supply immediately when finished.
14. Clean up machine and surrounding area after use.
